JULY - 2025





## Safety Officer

We all love riding motorcycles and what could be better than to share that pleasure with friends?

The dynamics of riding quickly get more complicated, however, as you add more bikes to the group. The following are some of the essential tips for riding with others.



## Motorcycle Hand Signals



SLOW DOWN Arm extended straight out, palm facing down, swing down to your



FOLLOW ME Arm extended straight up from shoulder, palm forward



LEAD/COME Arm extended upward 45°, palm forward pointing with index finger, swing in arc from back to front.



HAZARD IN ROADWAY On the left, point with left hand; on the right, point with right foot.



SINGLE FILE Arm and index finger extended straight up.



DOUBLE FILE Arm with index and middle finger extended straight up.



COMFORT STOP Forearm extended, fist clenched with short up and down motion.



REFRESHMENT STOP Fingers closed, thumb



TURN SIGNAL ON Open and close hand with fingers and thumb extended.



PULL OFF
Arm positioned
as for right
turn, forearm
swung toward
shoulder.



POLICE AHEAD Tap on top of helmet with open palm down.



Arm out to side pointing to tank with finger

Before you get on the bikes be sure that everyone knows where you're going. Inevitably there are times when the group gets separated. Discuss where you're going, where you expect to stop, and what you'll do if you do get separated. Exchange cellphone numbers. And then make sure the latest plan is clear each time you start out again.

## Safety Officer

Practice operating your motorcycle. Given the fact that motorcycles vary in handling and responsiveness. Be sure to take the time to get accustomed to the feel of a new or unfamiliar motorcycle. Ride your bike in a controlled area. Once you accomplish this you can take the bike into the traffic. Make sure you know how to handle your bike in a variety of conditions (i.g., inclement weather or encountering hazards such as slick roads, pot holes and road debris).

Before every ride check your motorcycles tire pressure and tread depth, hand and foot brakes, headlights and signal indicators. Make sure all fluid levels are correct. If you are carrying a passenger, he or she should mount the motorcycle only after the engine has started.

Keep your head on a swivel at all times Be Safe out there.

## Head Road Captain

### Hello Fellow Hogsters,

Well summer is here. Please stay hydrated and limit your time in the heat. We are planning rides for early morning or going up north to get out of the heat...

Keep your bike is good mechanical condition, not only is the heat hard on our equipment, you do not want to get stranded on the road in 105+ degree weather...

Keep an eye on your tires, with the heat, it will be hard on them.

#### Just some friendly reminders;

- 1. Check your bike every 500 miles or so, they are Harley's and they can rattle things loose.
- 2. Check your tires every time before you leave, tire pressure is really important.
- 3. Try to never ride in a vehicles blind spot, even if you see the light on in the mirror indicating that you are there. People just do not look.
- 4. Always turn your head and check before changing lanes, people drive like nuts and will try to sneak in even when there is no room.
- 5. Try not to ride next to semi's, if a tire blows, your day is going to turn bad in a hurry.
- 6. Be on the offense all the time, keep your head on a swivel. Sometimes people in cages just do not see us... We have to see them and be ready for them to do something stupid. If you expect it, you are more likely to be able to avoid it.
- 7. If you are riding on a two lane road and a semi or slower moving vehicle is coming at you, move to the right of the lane when possible, it gives a person that might be passing the slower vehicle a little more time to see you.

### From The Past:


