





PRE-RIDE CHECKLIST AND SAFETY CHECK FROM FIXMYHOG.COM

Motorcycle riding isn't always as simple as starting the engine and hitting the road. There are certain responsibilities that demand attention when it comes to motorcycle maintenance and preparedness. Making sure you've got all the right areas covered will not only ensure a safe, worry-free cruise for you, but it will keep others safe as well. 1. Fluid Levels

6. Operational Components

Ensure all components, from simple floorboards to complex spoked wheels, are in optimal condition. Thoroughly checking all operational components guarantees a smooth and safe ride, preventing unexpected issues that could arise from overlooked details.

7. Tire Pressure

8. Fasteners and controls
