



#### Happy New Year 2026 H.O.G. Family

As we come into the new year to ride together, we have to prepare for the cold weather here in Arizona. Be sure to check your tire pressure, in cold temperature your tire pressure may decrease by 1psi for every 10 degrees of temperature drop. Also check your lights and fluids before your travels. Dress in layers or bring extra clothes for when the temperature changes throughout the day. Below you will find a chart on riding speed to temperature change.

#### Hello HOGSTERS:

As a special note: with the cooler weather, it is imperative that you check your tire pressure before each ride, as the cooler weather has a tendency to reduce your tire pressure. Properly inflated tires are imperative for a safe ride and getting more miles out of your tires.

It is also important to dress in layers for the cooler weather and remember to stay hydrated even though the weather is cooler, we still need fluids in our system.

We just concluded our ride planning meeting and we have filled out our ride calendar through April with plenty of rides and an overnighter in March and a three ride to the valley of fire in Vegas. We also added new ride locations, so check them out.



On the computer it will ask you to confirm your email address and when it does it will ask you to login. Now it will say create new calendar or existing one. On a cell phone you add the App. If you have not already created an account, you will now do it. If you did or finished creating your account login, I will say create a calendar in larger print, but below in smaller print it will say open an existing account.
