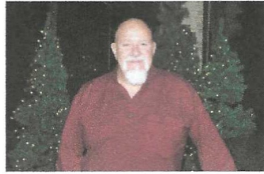

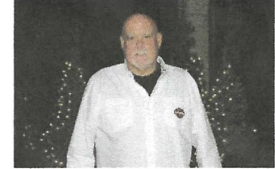

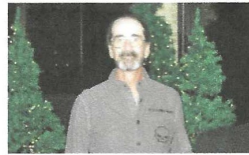

From The Purse Strings:

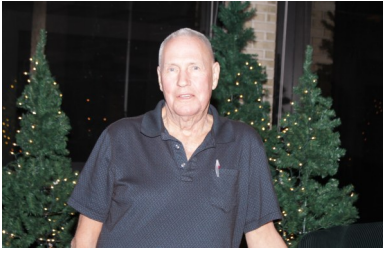

# Fool's Gear

# Cool Gear

**HEAD.** Considered precious by sensible people; *never* exposed by the pros. When fully in view, allows immediate identification of unsafe person not using his or hers. Hand out rider education info on sight.

**HELMET.** Most important piece of protective gear a rider can use. Protects against head injury, windblast, cold, and flying objects. Full-face helmet recommended.

**EYES, EARS AND FACE.** Exposure leads to irritated eyes, noise deafening windblast, and distracting impacts from bugs and road debris.

**FACESHIELD.** "Saves face." Any rider who's been hit in the face by stones, insects, or debris can tell you the benefits.

**HANDS.** *Are nature!* (not for long). Known to lock into curled position when exposed to cold; not genetically evolved to withstand abrasion.

**GLOVES.** Keep hands comfortable, functional, and protected. There's an infinite variety for all seasons.

**BARE LIMBS.** A phenomenon seen only in riders who think it's other people who crash. Subject to ridicule in riding circles.

**JACKET AND PANTS.** Long sleeves and sturdy trousers resist abrasion and protect against sunburn, dehydration, or hypothermia. Some riders wear padded gear with "body armor" for more protection. Light colors in the daytime and reflectivity at night make it easier for car drivers to see you.

**FLIP FLOPS.** Terminology for what sandals, toes and feet do upon contact with road surfaces, shift lever, brake pedal, or footrests.

**BOOTS.** Provide protection against foot and ankle injuries and give you a good grip on footrests or road surfaces.

**BOTTOM LINE.** Fool's gear identifies an unaware rider. Learn how to avoid embarrassment, ridicule and injury, while gaining valuable skills and knowledge by completing an MSF Rider Course®.

**BOTTOM LINE.** Dress for the ride as well as for the crash. Proper riding gear allows you to enjoy the ride in comfort and helps minimize injury.

As a special note: with the warmer weather, it is imperative that you check your tire pressure before each ride, check the tire pressure when the tires are cold, heat tends to give you a higher tire pressure reading. Properly inflated tires are imperative for a safe ride and getting more miles out of your tires.

It is also important to dress in layers especially for cooler weather in the morning and it heats up you can always remove a layer. Remember to stay hydrated especially as the temperature heats up. We still need fluids (water, sports drinks etc.) in our system.

Please remember to check the Team Up application if you have it on your phone, it has the most up to date information on all rides and other events. If you do not have the application, please contact Rich Sporski and he will assist you in putting the app on your phone.

Stay safe out there and keep the shiny side up at all times.

# Historian

## HOG 5104 THE CHAPTER THAT RIDES 3/4/26

2/12/26 -Regional HOG Director Chris Harrison briefed both Arrowhead and Roadrunner Chapters on the plans for 2026.

Referr to the 2026 Memeber Handbook and Benefits Guide for current activities and get upto date on the changes to the phone App.

2/14/26 ROC training was completed by 4 of our officers.

These 5 Harley – Davison Models that are considered to stand the test of time:

Debuted in 1990 – The Fatboy, Launched in 2009 – The FXSTB Night Train, Back to 1948 The FL Hydra Glide, a bold risk, The 1977 XLCR, The one that still exists today debuing in 1957 the XLCH Sporster. Food for thought and fun conversation.



## The 1926 Harley – Davidson Model JD.

This was the machine for the 1920's color options, Olive Drab. A new frame placed the saddle 3 inches lower, wider but smaller tires gave the bike a huskier look. Important to note, this was the debut of the tear drop tank, still used to this day in many forms. Still a Hardtail, softer for springs were added, a new contoured saddle, which offered a six - position height adjustment. The shift lever was moved forward along the side of the tank for convenience, and a fork mounted tool kit was added. Sidecars were a popular accessory of the day, as these vehicles often served as a primary form of transportation. The first of Harley's famed 74-cubic-inch V-twins was introduced in 1922 and continued with only minor changes through 1928. Upgrades included Iron Alloy Pistons replaced the previous Aluminum Slugs, and 16 Alemite fittings were added to the engine and gearbox to ease lubrication.

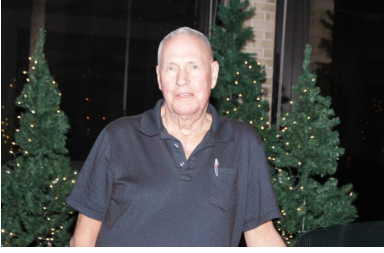
On a final note:

With the advent of social- media I have noticed that in truth the history of the chapter is being recorded in real time at rides by members through the various forms of social media, Hog Chapter Website, Facebook and so forth.
